IDROSCALO MILANO AND ITS SURROUNDINGS

Idroscalo Milano was built between 1928 and 1930 as a seaplane airport serving Milan's international connections. Located near Linate Airport, it was officially inaugurated in 1930. As aviation developed and seaplanes declined, the site gradually evolved into a major destination for sport, recreation and outdoor activities.

Today, Idroscalo is known as the 'Sea of Milan'. Its lake, beaches and green paths make it a popular meeting place for residents and visitors, as well as a venue for cultural events, concerts and international sporting competitions.

ORGANISED TRANSFERS

Teams may book transfers in advance by emailing idroscalogare@gmail.com. Prices are per person, one way, and depend on the airport of departure. Space for boats must be requested when booking.

- Milan Linate Airport: EUR 5 per person
- Orio al Serio Airport (Bergamo): EUR 20 per person; minimum 6 people
- Milan Malpensa Airport: EUR 25 per person; minimum 6 people

Alternatively, public airport shuttle services connect the main airports with Milan.

CAMPING

A dedicated camping area will be available within the venue's green area, with access to toilets and showers. The fee is EUR 20 per person, per day. Please confirm the number of guests by 25 September 2026.
